Comments:


In my opinion the paper is not worth of being published in this ranked journal for several reasons that I explain here. First of all data are too old and dated. **Quality** is an evolving subject and data and references from 15 years ago cannot make any contribution to the reference literature panorama. I suggest renewing the data underlying the work to make it current to the current reference economic landscape.

- Please write **Total Quality Management** with capital letters in text (p. 1 line 54).
- In the introduction section Authors write "On the other hand, Benzaquen and Pérez-Cepeda (2016) conducted an investigation in 211 Ecuadorian companies and the results confirmed that companies with ISO 9001 certification had a better score on all the nine TQM factors analyzed in the study, when compared to those companies that were not certified." You talk about certification, but you did not say anything before that point about the relationship between TQM and certification. And what is more which standard is related to **Quality** certification? This sentence here is not correct if not explained. Then you talk about **Quality management**... Please you need to explain all the relationships between TQM, **Quality management** and certification.
- When you speak about ISO 9001 in the literature review section, it is important that you underline that this is a family of standards composed of 3 main standards: ISO 9000 (that is not of 2005 but of 2015 the latest revision!!!!!!) ISO 9001 and ISO 9004. Therefore you must address to "ISO 9000 series" you cannot say ISO 9000, and the **Quality Management** System standard for certification is the ISO 9001:2015. What is more in this paragraph you do not explain in a clear way the relationship between TQM and ISO 9001. This is absolutely important to better connect the sections of the study.
- The paper says that a focus group has been conducted in 2005, that is, 15 years ago? Authors are trying to publish a paper with data collected 15 years ago? TQM and ISO 9001 have developed during 15 years and the ISO 9001 standard have passed through 2 revisions (that of 2008 and that of 2015). Now I understand why data and references are very old and now out dated. I do not totally believe that a work with data of 15 years ago could be of such relevance to be published in a journal of this high level! I am sorry but I reject the paper. It is confusing, it has old references and data and it is not well structured.

Reviewer Comments to Author

Methods: I did not find the research method clearly, so it is necessary to explain it with a separate title.

Results: The results of the research are pretty good, but it is necessary to add a matrix to make it easier to understand, namely:

1. Make a matrix table "resilience continuum vs. Supply Chain Resilience Factor" on point 5, page 15.
2. Make a matrix table "system Engineering attribute model vs. SCR" on point 7, page 21 so that the explanation of 7.1 - 7.6 is easy to understand as a whole for the reader
3. Make a matrix table "system attribute model vs. SCR" on point 8, page 26 so that readers can easily understand the following explanation

Interpretation: It's fine, but it needs to be explained in greater detail as to how it's done and how it affects the businesses that utilize it.

Other comments:

- a. Page 2 line 53 : It is necessary to add to previous research the impact of covid on the supply chain to show the phenomenon that what is being discussed is very important in a state of disruption.
- b. Page 2 line 57 : provide up-to-date literature, because supply chain vulnerabilities have been extensively researched, not new.
- c. Page 3 line 15 : firms and corporations. (Zsidisin & Wagner, 2006) change to -> firms and corporations (Zsidisin & Wagner, 2006)
- d. Page 3 line 16 : It is necessary to indicate the source of the literature so that all readers from all countries recognize this as a form of disruption or need to provide a more detailed explanation.
- e. Page 3 line 36 : add the journal of the last 5 years as an update on supply chain resilience or supply chain disruption
- f. page 3 line 41-45 for one sentence: Provide the source of this statement
- g. Page 4 line 12, 19 : Bruneau et al., 2003 change to -> Bruneau et al. (2003)
- h. Figure 1 on page 4 line 60 : Need an explanation in figure 1, why the loss estimation from the resilience triangle is in the vertical direction of the lowest point and returns from being at 50%.
- i. Table 1, you can be adapted from Hohenstein et al. (2015) and must be developed according to the latest conditions when you write articles.
- j. Example : for literature Hosseini et al. (2019) and Machowiak (2012, p. 280f.)
- k. Page 12 line 39 Readiness : This statement does not show in Table 1, so you need to look for journals to add to Table 1, which shows that Readiness is important.
- l. Page 10 line 30 : one paragraph should consist of 2 or more sentences.
- m. Need to add to the definition of SCR before the table 1 because it is essential in the line of thought: Blackhurst et al. (2011, p. 374), Carvalho et al. (2012, p. 331), and Cabral et al. (2012, p. 4831)
- n. Page 12 line 46 : Response -> You need to add an explanation about the response from the article: Dong et al. (2016), Torabi et al., (2015), Ponomarev and Holcomb (2009, p. 131), Ponis and Koronis (2012, p. 925), Wu et al. (2013, p. 676), and Kamalahmadi and Parast (2016, p.121).
- o. Page 13 line 13: Growth -> You need to explain growth from previous research in Table 1; if it doesn't exist, you need to complete it.
- p. inconsistent writing (and) or (&) citations used for two authors
- q. (Creswell & Creswell, 2005) and (Creswell, 2005) not written on the list in the reference : make sure all references are correct
- r. not used in the article as a citation: Azevedo, S. G., Govindan, K., Carvalho, H., & Cruz-Machado, V. (2013). Ecosilient Index to assess the greenness and resilience of the upstream automotive supply chain. Journal of Cleaner Production, 56, 131-146. : make sure all citation are correct
- s. make sure all the ways of writing references are correct and consistent

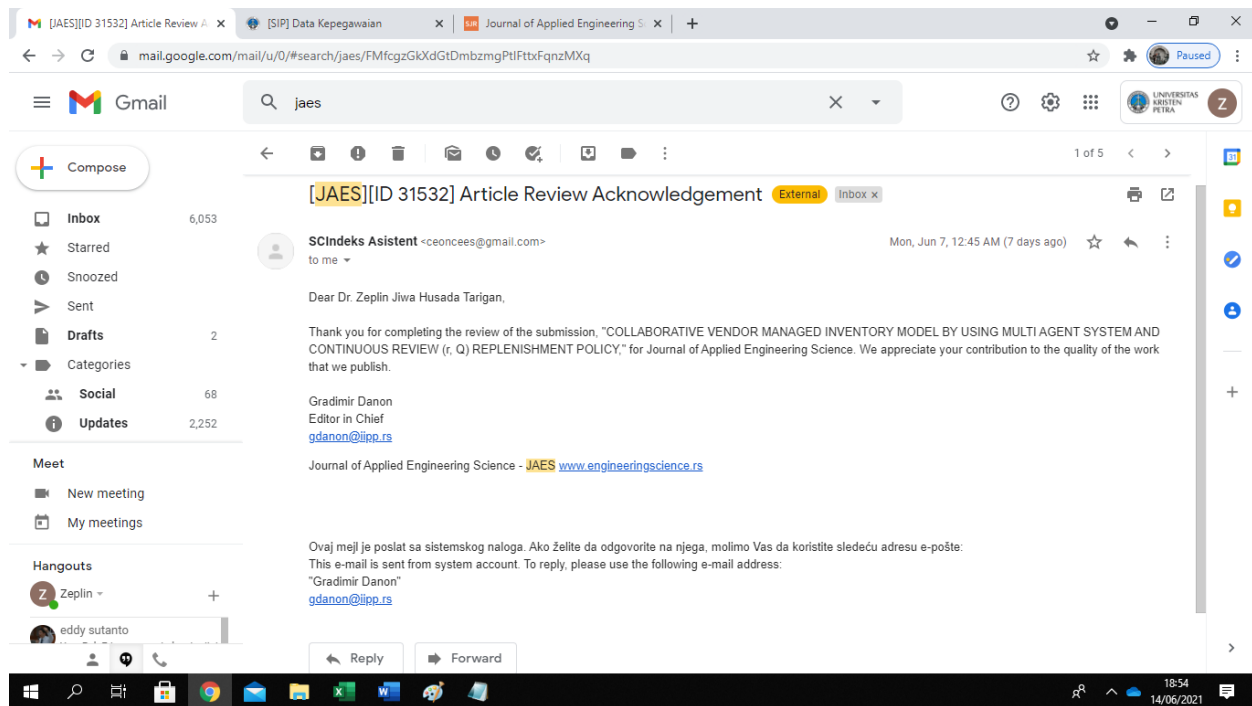
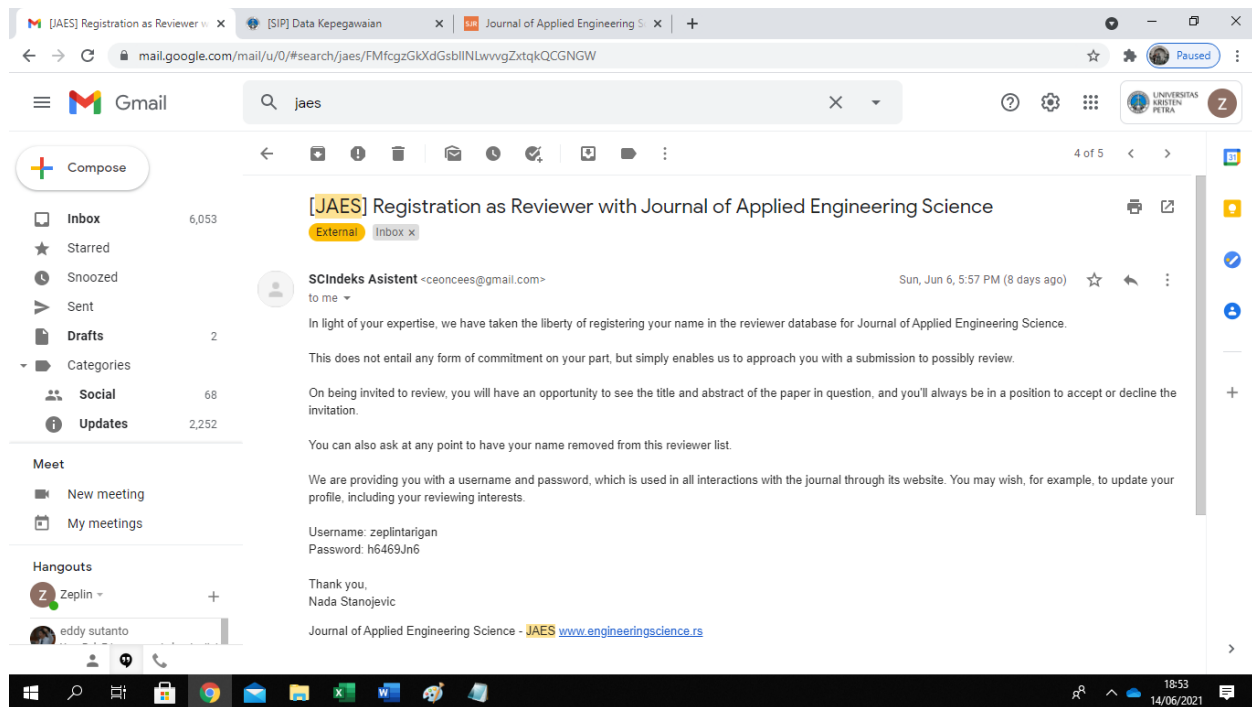
Abstract

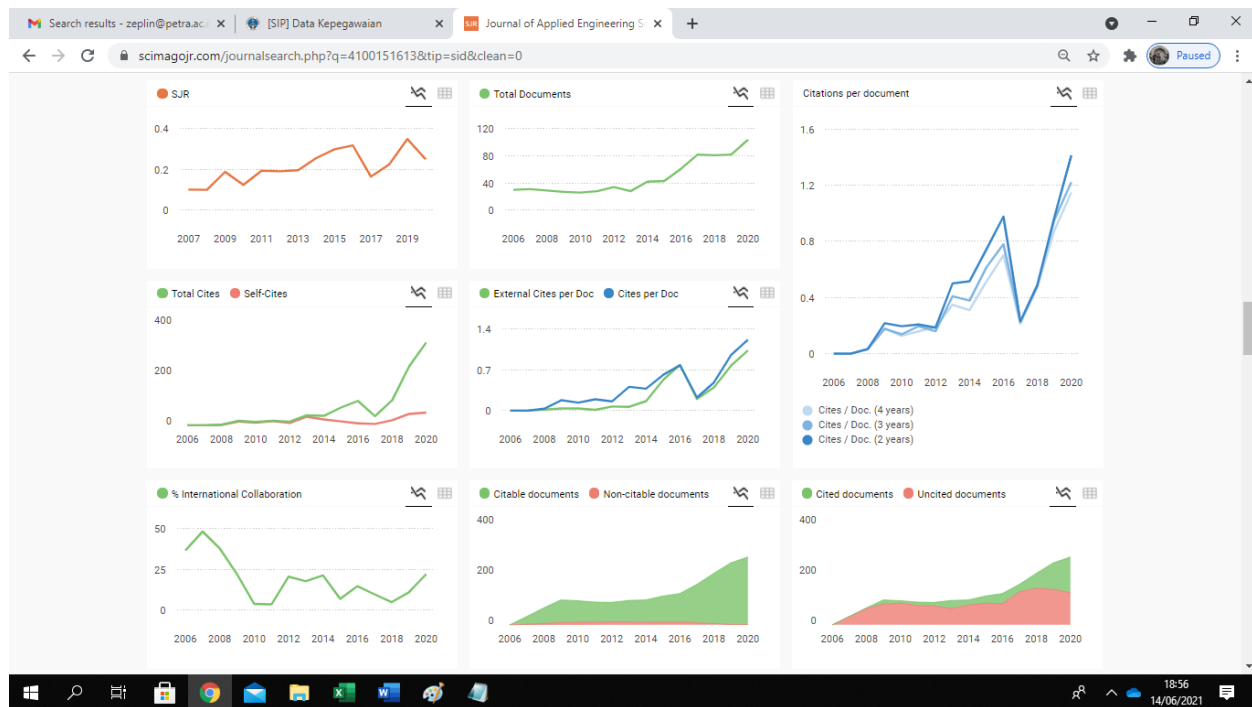
In the vendor managed inventory (VMI) system, the vendor takes over responsibility in managing customer inventory so that product delivery is not based on the order but customer's inventory condition. It makes the vendor becomes a dominant entity and customers are supplied by its own vendor exclusively. That is why most studies in VMI implement single-vendor single-customer or single-vendor multi-customer scenario. In certain condition, this exclusiveness can increase lost sales. Besides, most of them implement single product scenario. In this work, we develop VMI model for multi-vendor-customer-product scenario. This model is developed based on multi-agent system. A collaborative approach is adopted in this model. The relationship between vendors and customers is many-to-many relationship so that customers can be supplied by any vendors in the system. The reason for adopting a collaborative approach is reducing lost sales and maintaining efficiency in the inventory. The continuous review (r, Q) policy is used as the replenishment model. The simulation result shows that the collaborative model has advantages rather than the non-collaborative one. The collaborative model performs higher sales and competitive inventory. In its best performance, compared relatively with the non-collaborative one, the collaborative model performs 27 percent in lost sales, 127 percent in sales percentage, 120 percent in total retailers' stock, 70 percent in total vendors' stock, and 102 percent in total stock in the supply chain.

The present **research** proposes a theoretical extension of the Information System Success Model (ISSM) to evaluate ERP success at an organizational level in Jordan. It explores whether information quality, system quality and service quality have a positive impact on both perceived usefulness and user satisfaction as antecedents of organizational impact. COVID-19 incidence in India, impacted the food market, wheat in particular, as the crop harvest coincided with the lockdown disrupting the supply chain and prices posing a few researchable issues - the lockdown effect on wheat supply chain; how the state intervention bolstered the sector to restore; the insights the government interventions offer, etc. The study, using the interrupted time series analysis, investigated the disruption in wheat supply chain, and captured the impact of lockdown on wheat prices. Despite relaxation allowed to agricultural-related activities, lack of transport and labour shortage were reported. Nevertheless, the country registered a record wheat procurement of 38.99 million tonnes. Though the prices spiked post-lockdown, there was no evidence of structural-break and persisting volatility.
