Regardless, there are some review notes that must be revised before the conference day from our reviewer, which are:

Reviewer (1) – Accepted in High confidence

This paper has good experiments, even though it still needs to be explored about variables to be considered, such as the deep level of pipe into ground.

Reviewer (2) – Accepted in Medium confidence

The article is quite well written with clear findings, however some revision and clarification are needed, such as

- it should follow the standard writing guidelines, such as:
- p. 1, Zsokolo should be Zsokolay (2004), Kusuma should be Kusuma (2015), and similar mistake also applies to the page after that on p. 2.
- methodology:
- in p. 2, the last paragraph: ... and the width of the pipes is 16.3 m, what is meant is the length?
- P. 3, in the sentence 'Second . . . the ground surface was ...using a cover...', what is the material of the cover should be stated as it will affect the temperature as mentioned by Suparwoko (2018) that used stone?
- The research was done in three days, please explain the reason behind this decision (3 days only or 10 days will be more effective? The more data you obtain the better the results?
- Please state when research is carried out, dry or rainy season? It will certainly change the results?
