Comments from the Editor and Reviewers : <u>Reviewer #1:</u>

Because the variables in this study have been explored before in other studies, the author should discuss on how this study enhance the knowledge or important implications of the relationship between IT, IS, SCC and SCP compared to other studies.

Additionally, the author should add the questionnaire used in this study, how to develop the questionnaire and how to selected an informant in the chosen manufacturing companies to answer the questionnaire. Furthermore, the types of the chosen manufacturing companies should be displayed. These types of information would be beneficial in finding out if there is an bias in the answers in the questionnaire.

It is also suggested that the process of indicator selection should be provided. The clarification of the non-IT, non-IS, non-SCC and non-SCP including their cross-loading values in section 3.1.2 should be added.

For the descriptive results of IS indicators in 3.1.1, it shows that the average is lower than 4.00 and "Neutral" is greater than 20% of the answer. This should be taken into account for the discussion and the implication of this study.

There are also few mistypes in the manuscript. In section 2.2, volume or capacity flexibility, and production costs should be SCP3 and SCP4, respectively. The author should also consider re-write the explanation in 3.1.1.

Reviewer #2:

The study aimed to determine the effect of information technology implementation on supply chain performance through information sharing and supply chain collaboration in Surabaya, Indonesia. It was written well. Literature reviews included the topics of Information Technology Implementation (IT), Information Sharing (IS), Supply Chain Collaboration (SCC), Supply Chain Performance (SCP) and their relationship. They were up-to-dated. The research methodology was appropriated, which used a quantitative approach to measure the effect between an independent variable (IT), mediating variable (IS, SCC), and dependent variable. The population of this study was 206 manufacturing companies with more than 100 employees. The sample size of 70 respondents was calculated using Slovin [1], which was appropriate. The data was analyzed using Partial Least Square, which was a structure equation modeling technique. Most of the results were clearly

explained. However, in order to be consistent with others, the author might change the sentence from "... non-IS' cross-loading values (0.149~0.671) are lower than IS' (0.703~0.9).." to be "... IS' cross-loading values (0.703~0.9) are higher compared to non-IS' (0.149~0.671) in Line 41 below Figure 2.

This paper could benefit to practitioners with insight to the importance of IT, IS, and SCC to pursue superior SCP. Also, manufacturing companies that want to improve their supply chain performance can adopt the results of this study. In addition this paper could contribute to the current research in supply chain management.
