Reviewer #1: Comments to author

In this paper, the authors looked at Lighting Control Systems (LCSs) to address issues of indoor lighting in classrooms while accommodating diverse learning activities. The research topic is consistent with the journal scope. Nevertheless, my recommendation is a reconsideration following a major revision. Here are my comments.

Title and Abstract:

-The title is not clear. Please review it.

-I'd suggest reviewing the abstract section as it looks like the concluded remarks of the study. The abstract is missing a clear research problem/gap and methodology.

Introduction:

-The introduction section lacks a clear and concise overview of the key issues. The authors need to critically evaluate the findings of the previous work and identify the flaws within the previous methods of controlling light systems.

-Page 3, p 6-10: "Recent studies have rarely focused on the dynamic nature of classroom activities and the need to accommodate various tasks,). I invite the authors to have a look on this article which tackle lighting in classrooms for multiple activities and viewpoints. https://ascelibrary.org/doi/abs/10.1061/%28ASCE%29AE.1943-5568.0000533

-The literature review needs to focus more on investigating controlling methods using luminance/illuminance meters, HDR photography, etc. and identifying their limitations and related energy/comfort implications. Again, the research gap of the study needs a clear definition and articulation. -Page 3, p 13-25: Whatever you decide to do to achieve your goal goes to the methodology section.

Research Methodology:

-Have the authors established a baseline to compare the proposed LCSs against?

-What are the commercial products used to validate HDR measurements? Please state them.

-On what basis the authors choose green papers to capture the luminance on them. In fact, mid-range grey targets are used as they showed to produce lower errors in terms of luminance than colored, black, or white targets. Check these articles:

https://doi.org/10.1191/1365782806li164 https://doi.org/10.1080/15502724.2019.1684319

-It remains unclear why the authors have chosen those luminance values that control the movement of the blinds. This needs a proper justification. -One of the major drawbacks of the method is the adaptation time allowed before filling in the questionnaire, particularly for questions concerning non-visual effects of light. Moreover, physiological symptoms can be influenced by many factors other than light.

-The full questionnaires can be moved to the appendix section.

Results:

-Please comment on how would different times of day and different sky conditions possibly affect your findings.

-The reason for using two glare indices is not clear to me. Same as for using the statistical test Mann–Whitney U instead of the Kruskal–Wallis. -Overall, having an unclear research objective has definitely reflected on the solidity and clarity of the data analysis, reporting and interpretation.

Reviewer #2: Dear Authors,

The article is interesting, however, several light control systems are available. How do you justify that your new system is better than the available system? In addition, please answer the following questions:

1. The abstract is missing the study methods. Please as appropriate.

2. The point number one in the highlight should be more specific. Because there are several systems available for this purpose.

3. The is no need to make a sub heading for Aims and novelty.

4. It is not clear the correlation between the six hypothesis, the methodology, the results and discussion and also the conclusion of study. In the introduction, six hypothesis are proposed but in the methods no explanation on how to test these hypothesis. No explanation in the results and discussions about the hypothesis. Finally, there is no explanation on how the study reach conclusions based on the six hypothesis. Therefore, what the role of these hypotesis?

5. The illustrations are quite small and not so clear. Please check the resolution of the images used in this figures.
